CROP MATERIALS


If you are not able to attend a Recruiter Rally to pick up your CROP supplies just stop by the Interfaith Conference. We have everything you need!

OCTOBER 9TH

Registration will take place from 12:30 - 1:30 p.m. at the McKinley Marina. To register, you and your walkers must turn in the detachable top sheet from the walker sponsor sheet. (See WALKERS) At 1:20 we will begin the brief pre-walk program and then we'll send the walkers off!

WALKERS

VERY IMPORTANT: EVERY walker must bring the detachable top sheet of the sponsor sheet on October 9 with the Statement of Consent box in the lower left corner signed by the Walker or their parent/guardian. This sheet will serve as their insurance card in case someone is injured during the walk.

LOOK FOR IT!

Look for the list of names of all the congregations and groups that signed up to participate in the CROP Hunger Walk. Make sure to let us know that your group is there and how many walkers you brought. If you don't see the name of your group just add it to the list!

FOOD

Bring your food donations to the McKinley Marina on the day of the CROP Hunger Walk. Volunteers from Congregation Shalom and Hunger Task Force staff will be available to collect the tons and tons of food that you bring to the lakefront. Let's make sure we keep them busy!!

WEATHER

Remember why we are doing this. We walk because they walk. The CROP Hunger Walk will go on regardless of the weather rain or shine or sleet or snow. Be sure to listen to the forecast, dress appropriately for the weather and wear comfortable walking shoes.

HAVE FUN!

- a) Our walking is symbolic of how people in developing countries must walk for miles everyday to receive food, water and medical attention. However, you will be among hundreds and hundreds of caring and generous people who live in our community. Take advantage of that time together.
- b) Dress alike as a team and have everyone wear fuchsia or blue with red polka dots or whatever you would like to distinguish your group from others. We will also have hats, tote bags and commemorative CROP t-shirts available to purchase at \$10 each.
