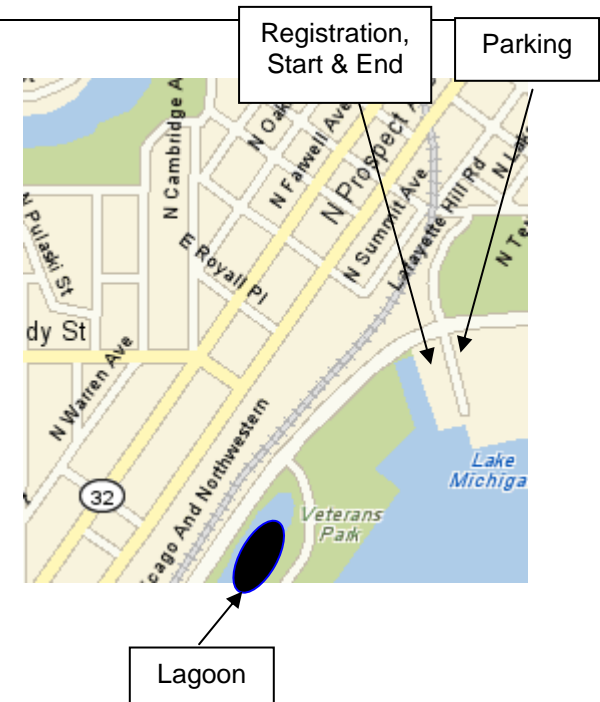
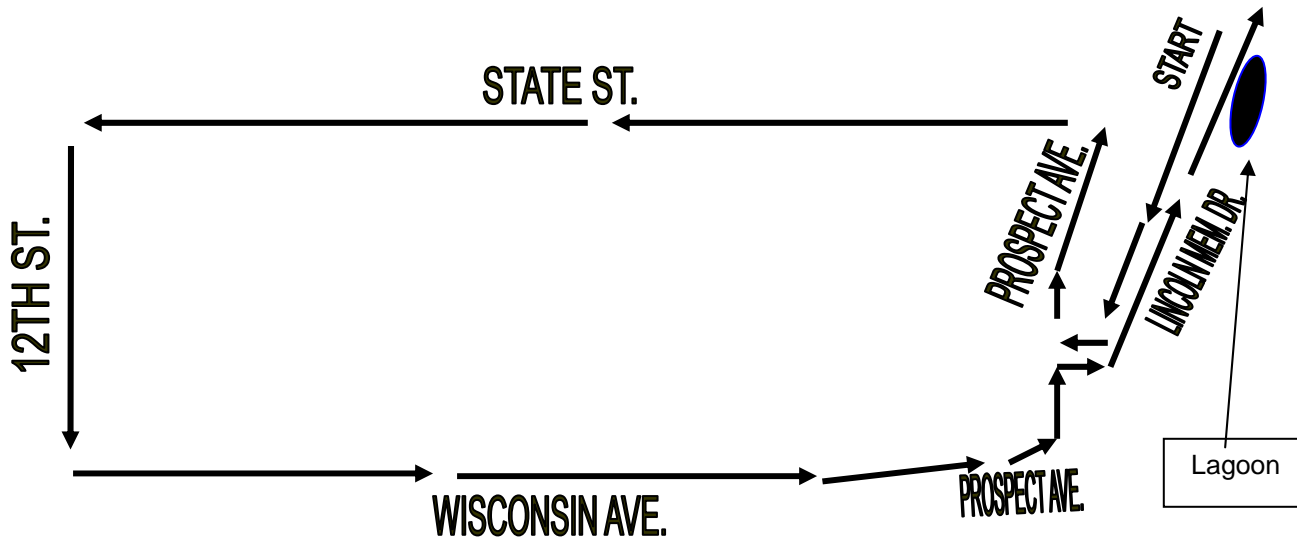

The **SHORT ROUTE** will circle the lagoon at Veterans Park, approximately a 2 mile walk.

The **LONG ROUTE** is approximately a 5.5 mile walk through downtown Milwaukee. See the map below for the route.

LOGISTICS

- **Registration:** Registration begins at 12:30 p.m. just south of the parking lot. Look for the tents and signs.
- **Food Donations:** A Hunger Task Force truck, staff and volunteers will be available to collect your non-perishable food items.
- **Parking:** Free parking is available at the McKinley Marina at 1750 N. Lincoln Memorial Dr., Slips A-D.
- **Restrooms, Food, & Drink:** Port-O-Potties, bread, and water are located at the start of the Walk near the Old Coast Guard Station (white building) and at the half-way mark of the long route at St. Benedict de Moor (9th and State St.).
- **First Aid:** Red Cross volunteers will be on hand for those who need assistance.
- **Weather:** In developing countries, residents walk every day for food and water whether it is scorching hot or pouring rain. We can and will walk through weather for a couple hours for one day so, please bring the appropriate gear, liquids, lotions, and potions. *We walk because they walk.*
